 - ~~and then I woke up from my dream.~~

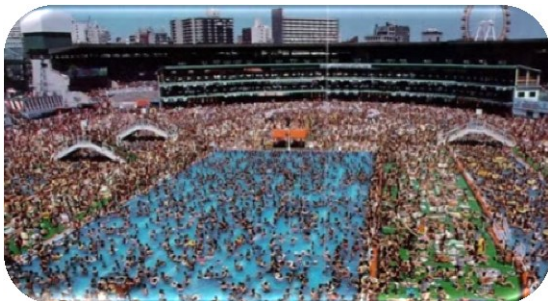
Directions: Use an ironic ending to complete each scene.
