
Presidents - Page 1



George Washington (1732 - 1799)

- "Father of our country".
- Commander of the Continental Army during the Revolutionary War.



John Adams (1735 - 1826)

- Lawyer, statesman, diplomat, Founding Father.

Thomas Jefferson

- (1743 1826)
- Founding Father, lead writer of Declaration of Independence.

James Madison

James Monroe


(1758 - 1831)

- Supported Liberia, a colony in Africa for freed slaves.




John Q. Adams (1767 - 1848)

- He would swim the Potomac River early in the morning.




<u>Andrew Jackson</u> (1767 - 1845)

William H. Harrison


- (1773 1841)

(1790 - 1862)


- Helped annex the country of Texas in 1836.

Zachary Taylor

Millard Fillmore


(1800 - 1874)

Franklin Pierce (1804 - 1869)

- (1791 1868)
