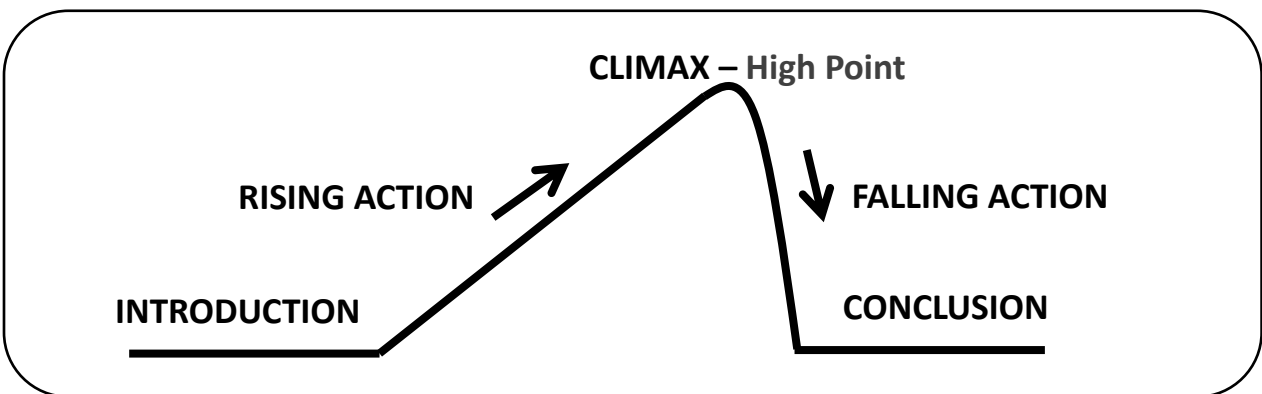


Olympics *Suspense Writing*
