- Only 1,100 people live in Antarctica (mostly researchers)
- The continent is twice the size of Australia.
- No countries own Antarctica. Thirty-eight countries have pledged to use the continent for scientific purposes.
- Antarctica is a desert, with less than 10 in. of precipitation per year.
- The South Pole elevation is 9,300 ft. and has a telescope searching for galaxy clusters. Its record high temperature is 10° F. and record low -117° F.
  From September to March, the sun never sets. From March to September, there is no sunlight at all.
