## **April Fools**

The origin of April Fools' Day is unclear. It is at least 450-years old but likely comes from earlier traditions. The day possibly evolved from ancient festivals in northern Europe. Since the day is April 1, it may have originated as a medieval renewal festival, celebrating the transition from winter into spring. and permitting lies and deception of others.

The most likely theory stems from the French calendar change in 1564. In this year, France changed the start of the calendar from the end of March to January 1. Those who didn't switch to the new calendar system may have been considered the April Fool, and in France that meant mocking and playing pranks on these fools, like sticking a paper fish to their backs.
